In the academic year 2018-2019, the Student Welfare and Scholarship Committee passed and implemented some important proceedings for the overall development of the students. Following is the annual report of the work done by the committee.

For that, the committee followed up with the college administration and management and prepared a shelter shed.

The passenger shelter at the gate of the college was dilapidated. The committee decided to amend it. For that, the committee followed up the college administration and management and repaired the passenger shelter shed.

The committee has taken some important decisions and implemented them for the convenience of the students with backward class scholarships. Importantly, a resolution was passed to open a bank account for the scholarship. For this purpose, nationalized bank and post office staff were called to the college and the students' bank accounts were opened. A workshop was organized for the scholarship holders. In it detailed information about MAHA-DBT Portal was given and training on how to fill the online scholarship form was given along with demonstration. Due to this effort of the committee, 518 students of the college got the benefit of Government of India scholarship in the academic year 2018-2019.
