Introduction

Methodology

The students responses are collected and analyzed based on 21 questions designed by NAAC in which 20 Questions are based on Multiple choices and last Question were asked about their suggesting in brief.. It seems that the survey was created by experts and leaders in the education to assist the educational institutions to define the success of the most important aspect of education- teaching and learning. Sample Size

Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted by a team of teachers and a volunteer students. It is very difficult and time taking activity to collect SSS from each and every student so it is decided that by using random sampling method only 100 sample were finalized and SSS
