## **Methodology**



tools like percentage, etc. have been used. For the effective presentation of the data, various types of graphs have been used.




**Graph No.1: Gender Wise Classification of Student Respondents**




**Graph No.2: Class Wise Classification of Student Respondents**




**Graph No.3: Subject Wise Classification of Student Respondents**




**Graph No.4: Response about the syllabus by student respondent**




**Graph No.5: Response about the benefit of the syllabus by student respondent**




**Graph No.6: Response about understanding of the syllabus by student respondent**




**Graph No.7: Response about syllabus covered in classroom by student respondent**




**Graph No.9: Response about availability of material and facility in library for the course by student respondent**




**Graph No.10: Response about preparation of the teacher for the course by student respondent**




**Graph No.11: Response about teacher communication in the class by student respondent**




**Graph No.12: Response about methodology used by teacher in the class by student respondent**




**Graph No.13: Response about internal assessment by student respondent**



useful statistical tools like percentage, etc. have been used. For the effective presentation of the data, various types of graphs have been used.




**Graph No.1: Gender Wise Classification of Student Respondents**




**Graph No.2: Class Wise Classification of Student Respondents**




**Graph No.3: Response on availability of Library material by Student Respondents**




**Graph No.4: Response on promptness in display & make availability of new and unavailable material by Student Respondents**




**Graph No.5: Response on service provided and behavior of library staff by Student Respondents**




**Graph No.6: Response on awareness about library created through library staff by Student Respondents**




**Graph No.7: Response on availability of reprography facility in library by Student Respondents**




**Graph No.8: Response on information about admission, exam and scholarship given by office by Student Respondents**




**Graph No.9: Response on easiness in admission, exam and scholarship form submission by Student Respondents**




**Graph No.10: Response on communication and displaying various notices through office by Student Respondents**




**Graph No.11: Response on promptness in providing various services through office by Student Respondents**




**Graph No.12: Response on behavior of office staff and their promptness in problem solving of student by Student Respondents**




**Graph No.13: Response on cleanliness of college, library, classroom and campus by Student Respondents**

## **Feedback from stakeholders**

Feedback from stakeholders i.e. students, teachers, parents, alumni and employers are collected about curriculum, teaching methods, infrastructural facilities etc. Sample feedbacks were collected suggestions, recommendations received are analyzed and analysis reports are submitted/forwarded to respective individual/agency for further necessary updation/actions. The feedbacks are collected on random selection basis from the stakeholders and analyzed by the constituted committee having internal quality assurance cell (IQAC) coordinator as one of the member. The analysis report of the feedback is passed on to Principal which is then placed and discussed into IQAC meetings, these findings are also represented into meetings of college development committee (CDC).
